

IIRSM Health & Safety Governance

Description

Our Health & Safety Governance course educates delegates on their role in Safety Leadership within the organisation, whilst also allowing them to review their current systems. At the end of the course, delegates will create an Action Plan, where they will identify what the next steps are to improving their governance of health and safety.

This course, delivered by experienced health and safety professionals, will also give delegates the opportunity to explore more broadly the implications of health and safety at the strategic level of an organisation.

Aims

Delegates will understand their role in safety leadership and will be able to articulate a number of actions that they will undertake to assure the safety of people within and affected by their area's activities

Objectives

Delegates will:

- Understand how health and safety law affects them in their role
- Interrogate their own understanding of how their governance structures deliver the Organisation's Health and Safety Policy
- Be able to describe their impact on safety and their role in role-modelling good safety culture
- Identify a small number of actions that they may take to further their assurance of health and safety in their Domain
