

# IIRSM Safety Leadership

## Description

It is a truism but nonetheless important statement “if you don’t lead, others won’t follow”. We know that it is perfectly possible to lead in exactly the wrong direction. The safety leadership course explores the ideas of what it is to be a leader of health and safety. It provides delegates with the tools to become better leaders and allows delegates to explore ideas of health and safety leadership as well as practice with a range of leadership tools.

The 1-day course is designed to be highly interactive, using a mixture of examples, videos and facilitated workshops to provide delegates with the ability to develop a personal leadership plan.

## Aims

Delegates will understand their role in health and safety management, identify what opportunities exist for improvement and plan to achieve those gains

## Objectives

Delegates will:

- Identify their legal responsibilities
- Learn how to communicate about risk
- Explore how their leadership can drive the safety of those around them
- Reflect on their own safety values and what they mean
- Focus on one particular safe behaviour that they would like to enhance
- Consider how to measure safety performance

- What safety means for your team (what it is, what it looks like, where we want to be and what our challenges are)
- Leading safely (Understanding behaviours and how to make it easy to do the right thing)
- Measuring success
